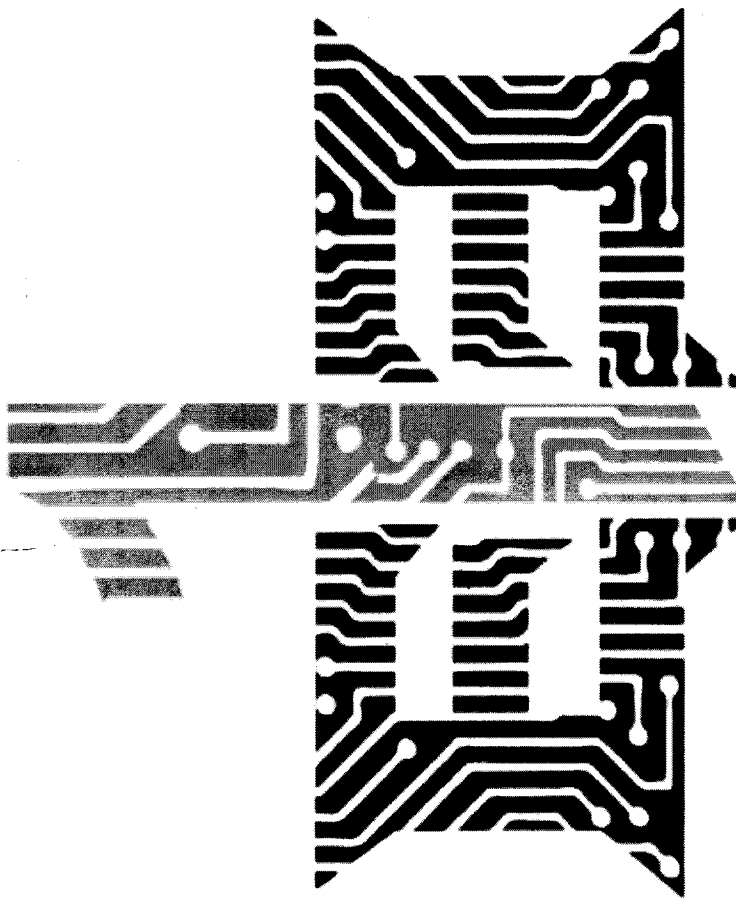

2006: Featuring PVC marimbas, brooms, pots and pans, this 30 minute show was complete with colorguard. Music: "Chicago"

2007: So much student interest caused the creation of two marching units and over 60 students involved. Music: "Earth Wind & Fire"

2008: Our first attempt to tell a story: "Time Trials."

2009: Featuring music by Stevie Wonder. Show includes the iconic 'Custodial Mishap' on imaginary drum kit.

2010: Buckets, drum battles and Rain! Music from Styx.

2011: Strings are back for the first time since 2005. Brooms, ocarinas and trashcans! Music by "Lady Gaga"

2012: Angry Birds, video game music, and British bands dominate the show. "British Rock" music is featured.

2013: All good things come to those who wait ☺. Nearly 70 students are in tonight's production.
