Departmental Updates:

- The itinerary for the music department trip has been finalized.
  - Reallocation of budgeted transportation funds has been shifted from paying to the bus to Omaha to paying for the rental of the truck to transport equipment and luggage to Florida. Cost is estimated to be between \$1600-\$1700. The reason the reallocation is necessary is that LPS refuses to pay for a vehicle that is not driven by an LPS employee. Trip account is actually in surplus.
- The choir concert is scheduled for April 8, 2014.
- Ticket sales for E-14 will start in mid-April, the decision to sell tickets on-line or not will be delayed until tax exempt status is known.
  - Rehearsals begin after spring break
  - The culinary and art departments will be helping with meals and sets for the production
- A current Booster newsletter will be ready by 4/8/14.
- Jazzfest was a "good experience" for the jazz band, the UNO faculty performed.
- Percussionists visited Campbell Middle School last month.
- Pep band may play at a spring track meet, in order to complete 16 performances. Playing at other events is also a possibility.
  - 8<sup>th</sup> grade night was attended by 5 kids from Goodrich and 1 from Dawes.
- Vale-grams were a success.
- The new wireless mics worked well for Beauty and the Beast, the pit performed well, and the Tea Party was a hit.
- A tour is being planned for jazz band. Schools that maybe included in the tour are Koozer, Clinton, Campbell, Schoo, and Goodrich.

The PE credit for marching band is now on the agenda for the next Principals' meeting in March.

The NSAA large group contest is to be held at Northeast on 4/14/14. Men's choir, concert choir, wind symphony, and orchestra will be participating.
